**3 million:**

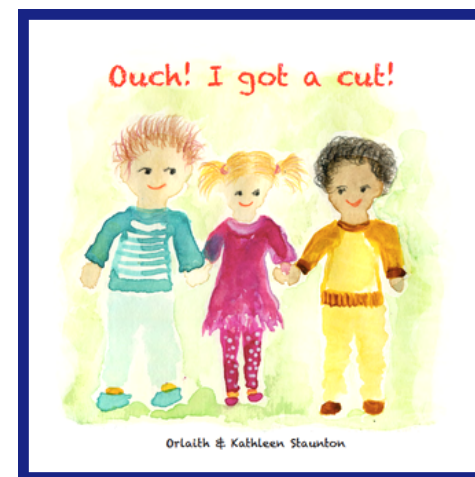
The number of New York State school children who now have access to quality sepsis education, thanks to the passage of Rory Staunton's Law.
